BAMart, Brooklyn Academy of Music's visual art program, reviews visual artist materials on an intermittent basis and for informational purposes only. The BAMart Curator reviews all submissions. If additional materials are required for consideration they will be requested by BAMart. Due to limited staff resources, the response period may take from six to eight weeks.

Submissions should include hard copies of all and only the following:

1. Cover letter
2. Resume
3. Artist statement/s, and up to 2 reviews or articles if desired
4. Representations of your work in the form of:
 - Up to 20 jpeg image files on CD-ROM only. Do not submit jpegs on DVDs.
 - Up to 10 minutes of time-based material on DVD only.
 - For web-based projects please submit the URL(s) in the cover letter. (This refers only to art works designed to exist online, and excludes personal artist web sites.)

Due to the large number of submissions received by BAMart, artists are now required to submit a physical package as detailed above. Materials that do not adhere to the specified quantities or formats will not be reviewed. Requests by email to have work reviewed from web sites are not accepted.

We do not accept, nor will we be responsible for, original work or models, slides, transparencies, videos, printed images, or books.

Please be aware that artist submissions will not be returned, even if you include a stamped self-addressed envelope. Submissions may not be picked up in person. Please do not call regarding the status of your submission.

All materials, including discs, should be clearly marked with the artist's name and contact details. Envelopes should be no larger than 8.5 x 11 inches (A4 size), marked "Artist Submissions" and addressed to BAMart, not a specific curator or person at BAM.
